Presenting a new golf destination, an area very well-known by the Italians, but not so much by the foreigners: we are talking about Asiago and the plateau from which it takes its name. The area is located in Veneto, in the province of Vicenza, on the border with another region: Trentino, in the foothills of the Alps.

The area is also renowned for the production of cheeses whose denomination is precisely Asiago. Unfortunately, Asiago is also famous for a terrible battle (the Battle of the Plateaux) that took place during World War I, in May 1916, that left 230,000 dead on the field and many of these were British soldiers. Also Ernest Hemingway fought here



For what regards golf, Asiago has one 18-hole course, considered one of the most beautiful mountain courses in Europe, designed by Peter Harradine, the famous golf architect known for his great experience in mountain fields.

The great advantage is that, despite being in the mountains, it is played on a plateau, along a gentle and panoramic path, without particular differences in height, guaranteeing players to be able to play their ball with their feet always flat.


Built in 1960 with nine holes designed by J. Harris, the course has been completely renovated with 18 holes. The particular environmental characteristics facilitated the success of the project and the entire work was carried out respecting the precious ecosystem that gravitates around the golf club.

The intention is to complete the course with other 9 holes.

Asiago is also the perfect destination for golfers who are also fond of biking and walking. In fact, the trails are so many that any day you can combine a round of golf with an excursion around the plateau accompanied by a local guide.

We can also organize the rental of e-bikes (Thok and Ducati models) so that everybody can enjoy this activity exploring the area, even those who do not have a technical preparation.
